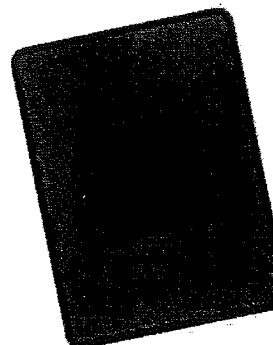

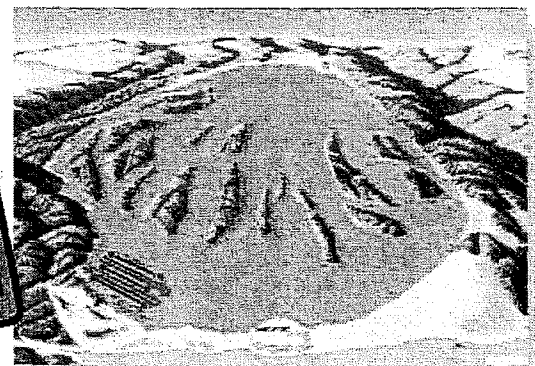
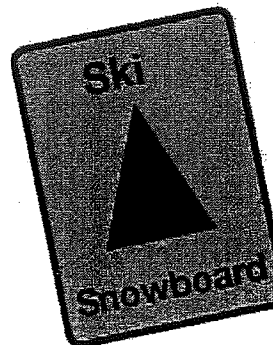


Skiers:

Bittersweet Student Ski/Snowboard Club Program

The Bittersweet Student Ski/Snowboard Club Program is designed to encourage members to improve their skiing or snowboarding skills. Each paid member will receive a membership card, which entitles the student to receive two complimentary lessons as well as a discount on lifts and rentals for skiing and snowboarding. Students, especially beginners, are encouraged to take lessons. All students must take a skill EVALUATION before being allowed on any slope rated more difficult than the beginner hill. The evaluation consists of the students demonstrating their best skiing skills on the beginner hill. (Takes approximately 10 minutes.)

All students must purchase a daily Student lift ticket to use any of the hills, and must have an evaluation ticket if they are using any chairlifts.

No evaluation ticket
(working on stopping and turning)

Student remains on Beginner Hill serviced by tow ropes and Wondercarpets.

Green evaluation ticket
(Skiers - wedge turning and stopping)
(Snowboarders - direction changes with a stop)

Can use chairlifts 1 and 2.

Blue evaluation ticket
(Skiers - wedge Christy turn)
(Snowboarders - edged direction change.
Able to stop both sides.)

Can use chairlifts 1, 2, 3 and Sweet Express chair

Orange evaluation ticket
(Skiers - dynamic parallel turns with pole plants.)
(Snowboarders - dynamic turns, fakie turns.)

ALL AREA (Note: Freestyle skills required for Terrain Park. We do not teach and cannot evaluate students for using the Terrain Park.)

A word of caution: The evaluations are a guideline for the student, sponsor, parent and area personnel to determine and encourage the student to learn a life-long sport safely for themselves and others.

Snow conditions change and students must understand the importance of skiing and snowboarding under control at all times.

The club sponsor is an integral part of making the program work. Helping the students understand how the evaluation process works is as important as organizing the student's paperwork and cards, setting up a weekly club day, helping students with lift tickets, rentals, etc., and safety on the hill. The sponsor's and the program's goals are the same - to make the student's visit a safe and fun learning experience.
